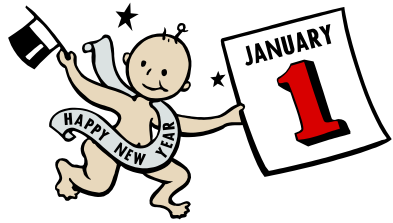

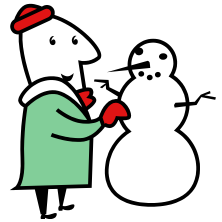

Please remember we try to go outside everyday as long as the temperature is at least 32 degrees and all children will go outside with their class. Your child must have the proper clothing to go in the snow. We ask that you provide the following to keep your child as warm and dry as possible:

- snow pants
- snow boots
- gloves or mittens
- a winter coat
- a hat or hood on the coat

Also, please make sure your child has an appropriate winter change of clothing in his or her cubby. Even if your child never has “bathroom type” accidents they can and do frequently have paint, drink, or other types of spills on their clothing.
